1. MINUTES

2. TRIBUTES TO LIVES LOST

(i) Manchester and London terror attacks

Cabinet wished to place on record its thoughts to the victims and families affected by the recent terror attacks in Manchester and London. The Council had marked these horrific events by lowering all flags at the Town Hall to half mast. It had also offered its support to the local authorities affected.

(ii) Sean Lawson, Head of Environment and Public Realm

Cabinet wished to place on record its sympathy to the family and friends of Sean Lawson, Head of Environment and Public Realm, who tragically passed away with his wife on 28 May 2017. It also paid tribute to Sean's colleagues, in particular the Council's Senior Management Team, for continuing their work in such a professional manner under difficult circumstances. The Leader also thanked external bodies for their support at this time, including Reverend Imogen Nay and Reverend Margaret Simmons who had both offered ongoing pastoral care to employees.

The Environment and Public Realm Portfolio Holder added that Sean had been a huge support to her in her work and he would be missed greatly.

All Members and officers stood in a minute's silence in memory of those who had lost their lives in the terror attacks and in memory of Sean.
